AGENCY APPOINTMENT FOR THE SALE OF HOUSEHOLD LEAVEN

Our Tradition informs us that we may neither eat nor possess any leavened product during the Passover holiday. Hence we plan to finish or dispose of our breads, crackers, et al before the Yom Tov. The Rabbis devised an additional option, which allows us to appropriate our household items that are too costly to throw away for sale to a non-Jew. While the ideal step of "selling the chametz" is to perform a live transaction, or kinyan, with the Rabbi, the completion of this form will enable him to represent you and your household on the eve of the festival.
